A WORD FROM FATHER BRANDON

After this weekend, I will be heading off to my 30-Day retreat which I have been anticipating and planning for over a year now. As I've said previously, I will be away at the campus of Creighton University, Omaha, from 23 June to 29 July. Over those five weeks, Fr Ray is covering - a favor I am eternally grateful for! There is one weekend (next weekend) that you'll have Fr David Renne from Saint Mark Seminary & Gannon University, Erie, coming down to cover. I appreciate the huge favor Fr Ray is giving me in being so willing to cover the daily Masses, confessions, funerals, and weekend liturgies! I am, and we are, so blessed to have him here at Saint Michael! I look forward to seeing you on my first weekend back, 3 & 4 August. I am super excited to be going on this – I can't wait! I think the hardest part of this retreat, though, is going to be not being able to preach! I do love that aspect of my life as a priest quite a lot, and not being able to engage in that aspect of my priesthood is going to be the hardest!
