Thank You St. Michael's - Let us Pray for Each Other

Praise the Lord Jesus Christ! St. Michael's, this is Fr. Brandon. No, not your wonderful pastor although I'm sure you would love to hear from him! This is Fr. Brandon Feikles, your parish seminarian from 2 years ago now, whom you loved and supported so beautifully up until this very moment. You first formed me and prepared me for my diaconate ordination. Now I sit at this desk before you, a week into being ordained a priest, I am moved with gratitude for how you have also prepared me to embrace my vocation to the priesthood. For all that you are and all you've done for me, thank you! It is also an honor to celebrate Mass here with you this weekend before I begin my ministry "pro temporae" in Brockway, PA under the pastorate of Fr. John Detisch. From my heart I wish to say to you now - thank you for all your love, prayers and support. Allow me to expand a bit.

Becoming a priest has been the greatest gift of my life. Every time someone calls me "Father" now, I feel my purpose for being on this Earth gets affirmed and re-affirmed over and over again. God made me to win souls for heaven. In celebrating the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, I feel I am offering the most perfect worship to God that I possibly can, and in this, my heart experiences the fulfillment I have been longing for since 2013 when I began to think about being a priest. Yes, it feels very ordinary most of the time, but even then, I know by faith it is the most extraordinary moment of all reality! I have been ordained to the priesthood of Jesus Christ to bring you Jesus and show you the Father - this is my heart's desire. I would be so bold as to say this desire exists in the heart of every priest, and rightly so - to bring you into an living relationship with Jesus Christ, so that you might know the Father in the Holy Spirit. This saves the world. Greenville, thank you. You have helped me arrive here. Please do not underestimate the influence you have had on my vocation... and the influence you will continue to have on future vocations.

Friends, again, you have helped me arrive here. If it wasn't for all the ways you have supported me, challenged me, loved me, and showed "ME" the face of the Father, I don't know if I would have had the courage to continue into ordination. We all know my discernment journey has been a long and arduous one, and at times that has had its toll on me. But being in a parish that loves Jesus, and me, has loved me helped my heart heal and grow into acceptance of my vocation. All I can say is thank you eternally. Let us then pray for one another.

Lastly, I want to encourage you and remind you just how powerful it is when a culture of vocations and love for Jesus is fostered in a parish. Tyler Smart came from this parish. You aided this new priest in his vocation. Fr. Brandon's love for Jesus has impacted all of us, including myself, to want to give my life as a priest. When we pour out our hearts to God, beg him for vocations, and start asking young men and women about vocations, the Holy Spirit blesses that. St. Michael's, my prayer is that you all continue to support vocations and beg God for more of them. I pray you will fall more in love with Jesus Christ, and know the Father. I pray you know how beloved you are to me, and how I will always remember my time in Greenville with great fondness of heart and much joy. I promise I will pray for you in Holy Mass, and I beg your prayers for me that I might be the priest God has called me to be. In the words of your pastor, St. Michael's.... I love you!
